EMERGENCY MOTION TO DISMISS PETER MATT'S EMERGENCY PETITION FOR AN EMERGENCY ORDER OF PROTECTION

I, Megan Mason, respondent pro se in post-decree activity related to the divorce finalized in this court on September 25, 2017, move that the court immediately issue an order dismissing Mr. Matt's EMERGENCY PETITION FOR AN ORDER OF PROTECTION. I fear for my safety and well being and that of my children if Mr. Matt is allowed to delay hearing on this Petition in order to have a specific judge issue a ruling, therefore I require emergency hearing on this Motion to Dismiss as stated in my Affidavit in Support of this Emergency Motion (Exhibit D). In support of my motion I state as follows:

Facts

 Mr. Matt filed an EMERGENCY MOTION FOR AN ORDER OF PROTECTION (Emergency Motion) seeking to prevent me from contacting my minor children, from speaking with their school staff or otherwise being involved in their lives on December 21, 2022 at around 10:50am. (Exhibit A).

- 2. Emergency petitions take precedence over other court matters. Mr. Matt provided an affidavit in support of ruling on his petition on an emergency, expedited basis.(Exhibit A)
- 3. On December 21, 2022, just before 6pm, court employee Diana Arroyo emailed Mr. Matt, by counsel Christopher Wehrman, the minor children's permanent guardian ad litem, Michael Bender, and myself, Respondent pro se. She wrote: "Good Evening, Judge Pinzur-Rosenberg will hear this emergency motion tomorrow at 11:30am" and provided parties with the Zoom details for the hearing (Exhibit B).
- 4. On or before December 22, 2022 all parties involved in this case, Mr. Matt via his attorney Christopher Wehrman, Michael Bender and myself were informed that Judge Robert Johnson would not be hearing motions for the twelve days following the filing of Mr. Matt's self described "emergency" action. I personally became aware of this fact when I received an automatic response from Judge Johnson's calendar email reading: "CALENDAR 23 WILL BE CLOSED ON DECEMBER 20, 2022 THROUGH JANUARY 2, 2023". (Exhibit C).
- 5. I believe Mr. Wehrman and Mr. Bender were aware of Judge Johnson's vacation at the same time I received this automatic reply, having received the same message.
- 6. On December 22, 2022 at around 10am, Mr. Wehrman wrote to Ms. Arroyo, "*Please be advised that we will <u>not proceed with the hearing on the petition today, and will re-notice it to Judge Johnson's calendar when he returns.*" (Exhibit B).</u>
- Judge Johnson will not be hearing petitions for another eleven days from the date of Mr. Matt's stated emergency petition to seek a restraining order against me.
- 8. I am employed full time and left work to attend this hearing.

9. I viewed this email from Mr. Wehrman on December 22, 2022 just as I was logging in for the emergency court appearance Mr. Wehrman had requested. I wrote:

"I object to re-noticing in order to obtain a more favorable ruling. I ask that you appear before Judge Pinzur- Rosenberg as I am now doing. If you have come to the realization that your petition is without merit, I ask that you withdraw it. If you have come to the conclusion that it is not an emergency, having burdened many parties, including myself, I ask that you likewise withdraw it. It does not make sense to delay." (Exhibit B)

- At 11:30am on December 22, 2022, as scheduled, Mr. Wehrman, myself and Michael Bender appeared in Judge Ginsberg's Zoom Meeting.
- 11. I was not given time to speak and Judge Ginberg stated that because Mr. Matt had decided not to have her rule on the motion that she would not let me speak. She stated without apparent basis, that she "would not give me legal advice". I attempted to state that I did not seek legal advice, but I objected to her allowing a delay of hearing on Mr. Matt's motion because it was described as an emergency.
- 12. Judge Ginsbert threatened me with contempt of court for persisting in my attempts to speak. She also questioned my friends who were in attendance in her public courtroom for their reason for being there. She abruptly decided to close her public zoom court.

Argument

- 13. Delaying ruling on a matter as serious as an order of protection in order to have that ruling be issued by a particular judge is on the face of it unjust. The court ought not to tolerate or encourage judge shopping.
- 14. A party must have a sincere wish to have expedited ruling on a matter in order to submit a petition on an emergency basis. By Mr. Matt's attorney's own statements and actions to delay ruling for eleven days, he has demonstrated without a doubt that this is not a

legitimate emergency. The court must therefore order him to withdraw the petition or dismiss it by order as he demonstrated it was not an emergency action, as stated.

15. Mr. Matt, by his counsel Mr. Wehrman, I and Michael Bender appeared at this action requested by Mr. Wehrman. The court ought to have dismissed the petition when Mr. Wehrman declined to prosecute his cause. I ask that it do so now.

Therefore I pray that this court:

- A. Issue an order dismissing PETER MATT'S EMERGENCY PETITION FOR AN EMERGENCY ORDER OF PROTECTION
- B. Any other relief that this court deems fit.
